

## DID GOD CREATE MORAL EVIL?

When taken out of context **Isaiah 45:7** and **John 1:3** are the foundation stones of the "god created evil movement". If God created evil, then He is both "good and evil", making Himself in agreement with the devil.

This my friends is a damnable lie! Does God allow evil to presently exist for CHOICE in mankind? Absolutely, God will not force a decision upon anyone. God does not want robotic family members, but children that grow in LOVE as He is LOVE, becoming children of Light.

**Satan is the "god" of good and evil** imprisoning his children in a mixture thereof. Satan can appear as an angel of light, but his light is corrupted, making his "love" (good), based upon vanity and pride founded only on selfish desire (I love , because I'm being loved).

**Isa 42:7 To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. Note: prison house, is this world.**

**Isa 14:17 [That] made the world as a wilderness**, and destroyed the cities thereof; [that] opened not the house of **his prisoners?** **Note:** Is Satan a CONTROLLER? What do you think? But do **we still have free choice?** Absolutely, because **one must first accept Satan's way**, before he can control him in the bondage of SIN.

**Note: Emphasis is mine in all scriptures- let the Word of God give you the answer. It is recommended that you take your time, reading all the scriptures; and allow a new vista of understanding to open up, and bless you richly.**

**Isa 28:10** For precept [must be] upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; **here a little, [and] there a little:**

**Isa 28:13** But the word of the LORD was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, [and] there a little; that they might go, and fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken.

**Consider the precepts:**

**1Jo 1:5** This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that **God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all.**

**1Cr 14:33** For God is not [the author] of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

**Jam 3:16** For **where envying and strife [is], there [is] confusion** and every evil work.

**Jam 1:13** Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

**Jam 1:17** Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. **Note:** God will not turn from the Light of his Truth, by shadowing it in mixture.

**Jhn 12:36** While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

**Eph 5:8** For ye were sometimes darkness, but now [are ye] light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

**1Th 5:5** **Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day:** we are **not of the night, nor of darkness**.

**Jhn 3:19** And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and **men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil**.

**Jhn 3:20** For **every one that doeth evil hateth the light**, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd.

**1Jo 3:10** In this **the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil**: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother. **Note:** the **devil fathered children** through MENTAL INTERCOURSE with Adam and Eve.

**These are the two scriptures used in the damnable lie, that God created moral evil. They capitalize on darkness and evil as moral issues.**

**Mat 7:15** **Beware of false prophets**, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

**#1. ISAIAH 45:7** "I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these [things].  
(darkness=anguish

evil= calamity) God was showing His greatness and power to bring about **terrible events (vengeance)**. These workers of lies conveniently take darkness and evil out of context. **Note:** The Hebrew word (**ra'**) has many meanings besides just moral, or ethical evil.

**Psa 94:1** O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself.

**Deu 32:35** To me [belongeth] vengeance, and recompence; their foot shall slide in [due] time: for the day of their calamity [is] at hand, and the things that shall come upon them make haste.

**Psa 99:8** Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God: thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions.

**Rom 3:5** But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? [Is] God unrighteous who taketh vengeance? (I speak as a man) **Note:** God's vengeance is righteousness-done for the good.

**Jer 18:8** If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them. (turn from).

**Note:** God uses vengeance to get mans attention-to wake one up.

**Jer 44:11** Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will set my face against you for evil, and to cut off all Judah.

**Amo 5:20** [Shall] not the day of the LORD [be] darkness, and not light? even very dark, and **no brightness in it?** **Note:** darkness- is a times of terrible trouble).

**Isa 13:6** Howl ye; for the day of the LORD [is] at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty.

**Joe 2:31** The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and the terrible day of the LORD come. **Note:** what once gave light is turned to darkness-the light will be put out.

**Jhn 1:4** In him was life; and the life was the light of men.

**Jhn 1:5** And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

**Gen 1:2** And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. **Note:** darkness came about, in chaotic corruption, by a satanic rebellion against God- darkness is symbolic death (bleak cold).

**Gen 1:3** And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.

Gen 1:4 And God saw the light, that [it was] good: and God divided the light from the darkness. **Note:** God did not say, "let there be darkness", but rather "LET THERE BE LIGHT". Darkness is the absence of LIGHT! Life is brought forth in the light- but deaths shroud is darkness.

**Psa 104:30** Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created: and thou renewest the face of the earth.

**Lam 3:38** Out of the mouth of the most High proceedeth NOT evil and good?

If God created everything through His Holy Word, He therefore must have created EVIL and DARKNESS? But could it be that **all things were created originally very good?**

**Gen 1:31** And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, [it was] very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

**2Sa 22:31** [As for] God, his way [is] perfect; the word of the LORD [is] tried: he [is] a buckler to all them that trust in him.

**Mat 5:48** Be ye therefore perfect, even as your **Father which is in heaven is perfect.**

**#2. John 1:3** "All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. The context for this scripture is "in the BEGINNING" **John 1:1** In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." God made everything good and perfect in THE BEGINNING! Lucifer was created perfect in the beginning- until he sinned. Satan is NOT a CREATOR-but a

**distorter-he bent and twisted God's creation.** God created good in the LIGHT (Glory), then Satan turned it into DARKNESS (removing himself from the LIGHT).

**Eze 28:15 Thou [wast] perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.**

**Note: God created Lucifer (the Light bringer); He did not create Satan, the destroyer of good (the adversary of God). Satan is a spawn of Lucifer's pride and vanity (beauty)- becoming the darkness of SIN. Lucifer shadowed (mixed and turned) his brightness, removing himself from the Glory of God, which once resided in him.**

**Jam 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.**

**Note: Please go to the web site below for an excellent study into Isa.45:7 - a scripture which is conveniently taken out of context. Evil here is referring to **hard times** – CALAMITIES, NOT MORAL EVIL.**

**Isa 5:30** "And in that day they shall roar against them like the roaring of the sea: and if [one] look unto the land, behold darkness [and] sorrow, and the light is darkened in the heavens thereof.

**Isa 8:22** "And they shall look unto the earth; and behold trouble and darkness, dimness of anguish; and [they shall be] driven to darkness.

**Isa 60:2** "For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.

**Zep 1:15** "That day [is] a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness,

**Jer 13: 16** "Give glory to the LORD your God, before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while ye look for light, he turn it into the shadow of death, [and] make [it] gross darkness.

**Amos 5:18** "Woe unto you that desire the day of the LORD! to what end [is] it for you? the day of the LORD **[is] darkness, and not light**.

**Micah 2:3** "Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, against this family do **I devise an evil**, from which ye shall not remove your necks; neither shall ye go haughtily: **for this time [is] evil**.

**Jer 49:37** \_\_"For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and **I will bring evil** upon them, **[even] my fierce anger**, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:

**Dan 9:13** As [it is] written in the law of Moses, all this **evil is come upon us**: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand thy truth.

**Eze 6:10** And they shall know that I [am] the LORD, [and that] I have not said in vain **that I would do this evil unto them**.

**Jer 32:42** For thus saith the LORD; Like as **I have brought all this great evil** upon this people, so will I bring upon them all the good that I have promised them. **Note**: all this **EVIL is Calamities- hard times, not moral evil**.

**Jer 45:5** And seekest thou great things for thyself? seek [them] not: for, behold, **I will bring evil upon all flesh**, saith the LORD: but thy life will I give unto thee for a prey in all places whither thou goest.

**Did God create Moral Evil?** At a certain college there was a professor with a reputation for being tough on Christians. At the first class, every semester, he asked if anyone was a Christian and proceeded to degrade them and mock their statement of faith.

**University**

**Classroom**

**Setting...**

"LET ME EXPLAIN **THE problem science has with Jesus Christ**," The atheist professor of philosophy pauses before his class and then asks one of his new students to stand. "You're a Christian, aren't you, son?"

"Yes, sir."

"So you believe in God?"

"Absolutely."

"Is God good?"

"Sure! God's good."

"Is God all-powerful? Can God do anything?"

"Yes."

"Are you good or evil?"

"The Bible says I'm evil."

The professor grins knowingly. "Ahh! THE BIBLE!" He considers for a moment. "Here's one for you. Let's say there's a sick person over here and you can cure him. You can do it. Would you help them? "Would you try?"

"Yes sir, I would."

"So you're good...!"

"I wouldn't say that."

"Why not say that? You would help a sick and maimed person if you could... in fact most of us would if we could... God doesn't." [No answer.]

"He doesn't, does he? My brother was a Christian who died of cancer even though he prayed to Jesus to heal him. How is this Jesus good? Hmmm? Can you answer that one?"

[No answer]

The elderly man is sympathetic. "No, you can't, can you?" He takes a sip of water from a glass on his desk to give the student time to relax. In philosophy, you have to go easy with the new ones. "Let's start again, son."

"Is God good?"

"Er... Yes."

"Is Satan good?"

"No."

"Where does Satan come from?"

The student falters. "From... God..."

"That's right. God made Satan, didn't he?" The elderly man runs his bony fingers through his thinning hair and turns to the smirking, student audience. "I think we're going to have a lot of fun this semester, ladies and gentlemen." He turns back to the Christian. "Tell me, son. Is there evil in this world?"

"Yes, sir."

"Evil's everywhere, isn't it? Did God make everything?"

"Yes."

"Who created evil?"

[No answer]

"Is there sickness in this world? Immorality? Hatred? Ugliness. All those terrible things - do they exist in this world? "

The student squirms on his feet. "Yes."

"Who created them? "

[No answer]

The professor suddenly shouts at his student. "WHO CREATED THEM? TELL ME, PLEASE!" The professor closes in for the kill and climbs into the Christian's face. In a still small voice: "God created all evil, didn't He, son?"

[No answer]

The student tries to hold the steady, experienced gaze and fails. Suddenly the lecturer breaks away to pace the front of the classroom like an aging panther. The class is mesmerized.

"Tell me," he continues, "How is it that this God is good if He created all evil throughout all time?" The professor swishes his arms around to encompass the wickedness of the world. "All the hatred, the brutality, all the pain, all the torture, all the death and ugliness and all the suffering created by this good God is all over the world, isn't it, young man?"

[No answer]

"Don't you see it all over the place? Huh?" Pause.

"Don't you?" The professor leans into the student's face again and whispers, "Is God good?"

[No answer]

"Do you believe in Jesus Christ, son?"

The student's voice betrays him and cracks. "Yes, professor. I do."

The old man shakes his head sadly. "Science says you have five senses you use to identify and observe the world around you. Have you seen Him? "

"No, sir. I've never seen Him."

"Then tell us if you've ever heard your Jesus?"

"No, sir. I have not."

"Have you ever felt your Jesus, tasted your Jesus or smelled your Jesus... in fact, do you have any sensory perception of your God whatsoever?"

[No answer]

"Answer me, please."

"No, sir, I'm afraid I haven't."

"You're AFRAID... you haven't?"

"No, sir."

"Yet you still believe in him?"

"...yes..."

"That takes FAITH!" The professor smiles sagely at the underling. "According to the rules of empirical, testable, demonstrable protocol, science says your God doesn't exist. What do you say to that, son? Where is your God now?"

[The student doesn't answer]

"Sit down, please."

The Christian sits...defeated(?).

Another Christian raises his hand. "Professor, may I address the class?"

The professor turns and smiles. "Ah, another Christian in the vanguard! Come, come, young man. Speak some proper wisdom to the gathering."

The Christian looks around the room. "Some interesting points you are making, sir. Now I've got a question for you if that's okay. Is there such thing as heat?"

"Yes," the professor replies, frowning. "There's heat."

"Is there such a thing as cold?"

"Yes, son, there's cold too."

"No, sir, there isn't."

The professor's grin freezes.

The room suddenly goes very cold. The second Christian continues. "You can have lots of heat, even more heat, super-heat, mega-heat, white heat, a little heat or no heat but we don't have anything called 'cold'.

We can hit 458 degrees below zero, which is no heat, but we can't go any further after that. There is no such thing as cold, otherwise we would be able to go colder than 458 -- You see, sir, cold is only a word we use to describe the absence of heat.

We cannot measure cold. Heat we can measure in thermal units because heat is energy.

Cold is not the opposite of heat, sir, just the absence of it." Silence. A pin drops somewhere in the classroom.

"Is there such a thing as darkness, professor?" "That's a dumb question, son. What is night if it isn't darkness? What are you getting at...?"

"So you say there is such a thing as darkness?"

"Yes..."

"You're wrong again, sir. Darkness is not something, it is the absence of something. You can have low light, normal light, bright light, flashing light

but if you have no light constantly you have nothing and it's called darkness, isn't it? That's the meaning we use to define the word. In reality, Darkness isn't.

If it were, you would be able to make darkness darker and give me a jar of it. Can you...give me a jar of darker darkness, professor?"

Despite himself, the professor smiles at the young effrontery before him. This will indeed be a good semester. "Would you mind telling us what your point is, young man?"

"Yes, professor. My point is, your philosophical premise is flawed to start with and so your conclusion must be in error...."

The professor goes toxic. "Flawed...? How dare you...!"

"Sir, may I explain what I mean?"

The class is all ears.

"Explain... oh, explain..." The professor makes an admirable effort to regain control. Suddenly he is affability itself. He waves his hand to silence the class, for the student to continue.

"You are working on the premise of duality," the Christian explains; "that for example there is life and then there's death; a good God and a bad God. You are viewing the concept of God as something finite, something we can measure.

Sir, science cannot even explain a thought. It uses electricity and magnetism but has never seen, much less fully understood them. To view death as the opposite of life is to be ignorant of the fact that death cannot exist as a substantive thing.

Death is not the opposite of life, merely the absence of it."

The young man holds up a newspaper he takes from the desk of a neighbor who has been reading it. "Here is one of the most disgusting tabloids you can buy, professor. Is there such a thing as immorality?"

"Of course there is, now look..."

"Wrong again, sir. You see, immorality is merely the absence of morality. Is there such a thing as injustice? No. Injustice is the absence of justice. Is there such a thing as evil?" The Christian pauses.

"Isn't evil the absence of good?"

The professor's face has turned an alarming color. He is so angry he is temporarily speechless.

The Christian continues. "If there is evil in the world, professor, and we all agree there is, then God, if he exists, must be accomplishing a work through the agency of evil. What is that work God is accomplishing?"

The Bible tells us it is to see if each one of us will, of our own free will, choose good over evil-" His way over Satan's way (**blessing or cursing**).

The professor bristles. "As a philosophical scientist, I don't view this matter as having anything to do with any choice; as a realist, I absolutely do not recognize the concept of God or any other theological factor as being part of the world equation because God is not observable."

"I would have thought that the absence of God's moral code in this world is probably one of the most observable phenomena going," the Christian replies. "Newspapers make billions of dollars reporting it every week! Tell me, professor. Do you believe that we have evolved from a monkey?"

"If you are referring to the natural evolutionary process, young man, yes, of course I do."

"Have you ever observed evolution with your own eyes, sir?" The professor makes a sucking sound with his teeth and gives his student a silent, stony stare.

"Professor. All previous attempts to explain how the process works have failed. Since no person has ever observed the process of evolution at work and cannot even prove that this process is an on-going endeavor, are you not teaching your opinion, sir? Are you now not a scientist, but a priest?" (in an act of faith).

"I'll overlook your impudence in the light of our philosophical discussion. Now, have you quite finished?" the professor hisses.

"So you don't accept God's moral code to do what is righteous?"

"I believe in what is - that's observable science!"

"Ahh! SCIENCE!" the student's face splits into a grin. "Sir, you rightly state that science is the study of observed phenomena. What you call "science" too is a premise which is flawed..."

"SCIENCE IS FLAWED..?" the professor splutters. The class is in uproar. The Christian remains standing until the commotion has subsided. "To continue the point you were making earlier to the other student, may I give you an example of what I mean?" The professor wisely keeps silent.

The Christian looks around the room. Sir, the basic law of physics says matter can neither be created nor destroyed, and yet you in spite of that believe in "spontaneous generation" of the entire physical universe! Spontaneous generation of vermin was disproved centuries ago.

Talk about straining out the gnat and swallowing the camel! Sir, biogenesis is "observable science" as you say--life has only been observed to come from other life of like kind--and yet you apparently still believe that that is exactly what happened--in spite of science--that life somehow came from non-life.

Young man, the professor began tersely, I believe that science will eventually....

"That science will eventually prove that matter can be created, that life can come from non-life" the young Christian interrupted? Sir, that's not science--that's faith! What you believe is the exact opposite of "observable science"! Your faith is in what you are calling "science", my faith is in God who created "science".

Make no mistake, Professor, we're both operating from faith."

There follows a long pause as the Professor stares the young Christian down without a word.

"Is there anyone in the class who has ever seen the professor's mind?" The class breaks out in laughter. The Christian points towards his elderly, crumbling tutor. "Is there anyone here who has ever heard the professor's mind... felt the professor's mind, touched or smelled the professor's mind?"

No one appears to have done so. The Christian shakes his head sadly. "It appears no-one here has had any sensory perception of the professor's mind whatsoever. Well, according to the rules of empirical, stable, demonstrable protocol and science, I DECLARE that the professor has no mind." The class is in chaos. The Christian sits... Because that is what a chair is for, and begins filling out a drop slip.

**Lucifer the light bringer, became Satan the destroyer:**

**Isa 14:12** How art thou fallen from heaven, O **Lucifer**, son of the morning! [how] art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

**Eze 28:14** Thou [art] the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee [so]: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. **Note:** Volcano- **pyramids (mid- fires)**.

**Eze 28:15** Thou [wast] perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee. **Note:** God DID NOT create the iniquity in Lucifer, **it was FOUND IN HIM**.

**Eze 28:17** Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

**Gen 2:9** And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; **the tree of life** also **in the midst of the garden**, and **the tree of knowledge of good and evil**. **Note:** the tree of "good and evil" was not good for food.

**Mat 7:17** Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.

**Mat 7:18** A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither [can] a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

**Mat 12:33** Either make the **tree** good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the **tree** is known by [his] fruit.

**Eze 28:13** Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone [was] thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, **the sapphire**, **the emerald**, and **the carbuncle**, and gold: **the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes** was prepared **in thee in the day that thou wast created**.

**Gen 3:3** But **of the fruit of the tree** which [is] in the midst of the garden, **God** hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. **Note:** the tree of ("good and evil") was deadly.

**Eze 31:8** The cedars in the garden of God could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chesnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

**Eze 28:17** Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.

**Eze 31:9** I have made him fair by the multitude of his branches: so that all the trees of Eden, that [were] in the garden of God, envied him. **Note:** He was made perfect in beauty. Lucifer was like a tree of beauty in the garden of God, when God first created him. But in corruption he became a Tree of death (a tree of the knowledge of "good and evil")-a blend of light and darkness (shadowed- MIXED).

**Rev 3:15** I know thy works, that thou art **neither cold nor hot:** I would thou wert **cold** or **hot.** **Note:** (MIXED- blended together).

**Rev 3:16** So then because **thou art lukewarm,** and neither **cold nor hot,** I will spue thee out of my mouth.

We realize this is symbolic of nations-Egypt, etc, but it was first symbolic of Lucifer, who became Satan (an adversary of God). Satan symbolically was manifested as a tree and a serpent, bearing the fruit of evil-God allowed it to be in the garden for CHOICE. Satan is not a CREATOR (making the seen and unseen from nothing), but rather is a PROCREATOR (by symbolic sexual reproduction). His thought (IDEA-male impregnator) by way of temptation, being lifted up (vanity-pride), entered mother mind (womb of generation) producing his child of carnality (one that will die) REASONING based on Pride (beauty)-and he SINNED. Satan obtained for himself a mind of DEATH.

**He separated himself from the LIGHT** of God, and **MADE HIMSELF** the "god of death"- in a mind in darkness. He broke the royal law of God's family kingdom-the **LAW OF LOVE!** His WISDOM became corrupted (carnal-not physical flesh, but spiritual flesh- a mind that would die-a mind of death). **Note:** the mind is a spiritual gift of (for) good- but Satan's became distorted by corrupt wisdom. The **word carnal means MEAT-flesh,** a **material that becomes corrupt** (decayed, destroyed-dies) within time (mortality- has an end-**death of darkness**).

**Rom 8:7** Because the carnal mind [is] enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. **Note**: not subject to Godly Love ( the Law of God's Kingdom).

Satan became a FATHER through mental union with Eve. He procreated a MIND of DEATH-becoming the "god" of death in his children of disobedience. How convenient, when they call Satan's carnal nature, "human nature", making it a natural part of humankind-very clever.

**Procreation -by definition:**

The process by which an organism produces **others of its kind**: breeding, multiplication, proliferation, propagation, reproduction, spawning. *Obsolete* increase. See reproduction/barrenness. The *noun* procreation

**Meaning**: the sexual activity of conceiving and bearing offspring- "Male - Female production. Symbolically speaking, Satan procreated, becoming a **father-male= thought** (a new knowledge) and united with **Female womb= mind**. Satan impregnated mother Eve's MIND- **thus producing the children of disobedience**. Satan originally bore his son of REASON by temptation, allowing father thought (new idea) to enter mother mind (his mind lifted in vanity and pride-by his brightness and beauty), and he SINNED.

**Eph 5:6** Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because **of** these things cometh the wrath **of** God upon the children of disobedience.

**Col 3:6** For which things' sake the wrath **of** God cometh on the children of disobedience:

**Jhn 8:44** Ye are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because **there is no truth in him**. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh **of** his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

**Eph 2:2** Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Satan's mind took on a corrupt (a mind of death) WISDOM:

**Note**: the mind is not physical-but is a gift of spiritual essence.

**Ecc 3:21** Who knoweth the spirit of man that goeth upward, and the **spirit** of the beast that goeth downward to the earth?

**1Cr 3:19** For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with **God**. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness.

**1Cr 2:13** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. **Note:** Holy Ghost, should read, Holy Spirit.

**Jam 3:15** This wisdom descendeth not from above, but [is] earthly, sensual, devilish. **Note:** Speaking of carnal wisdom.

**1Cr 2:4** And my speech and my preaching [was] not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

**1Cr 2:5** That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

**2Cr 4:4** In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

**Hbr 2:14** Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

**Note:** Godly **Wisdom is applied (put into action) knowledge** (after understanding has been established). GODLY WISDOM is an act (action) OF FAITH.

**Mar 6:2** And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing [him] were astonished, saying, From whence hath this [man] these things? and what wisdom [is] this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

IT IS NOT A SIN TO HAVE KNOWLEDGE -EVEN THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOOD AND EVIL-BUT IT IS A SIN TO INGEST IT and USE IT- TO SEPARATE YOURSELF FROM GOD'S LIGHT, ENTERING DARKNESS. But we can destroy the mind of the devil, by denying it (starve it to death), and it will vanish away in the virginity of a Humble Mind of God.

**Gen 3:5** For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. **Note: more than knowing- in USING** the corrupt mind of death you become "gods" unto (within) yourselves by reason of Pride (by self-justification).

**Gen 3:22** And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever: **Note: to know it is to understand it** (mankind had now come to the knowledge of it- and was now able now to use it)- but not to ever use it.

**Gen 3:6** And when the woman saw that the tree [was] good for food, and that it [was] pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make [one] wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. **Note: Adam and Eve ingested the fruit, taking on corruption, in the mind of the Devil by choice. Eve was fooled into eating the fruit of death-BUT ADAM EAT BY CHOICE**-bringing in the capacity to SIN upon all mankind, by way of Satan's CARNAL MIND of prideful (vanity of beauty- intelligence-knowing by brightness) reason.

**Rom 5:12** Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

**2Cr 4:4** In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

**Isa 14:17** [That] made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; [that] opened not the house of his prisoners?

**Isa 42:7** To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

**Gen 8:21** And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

**Mar 7:21** For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders,

**Mar 7:22** Thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an **evil** eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness:

**Mar 7:23** All **these evil things come from within**, and defile the man.

**Mar 7:15** There is nothing from without a **man**, **that** entering into him can **defile** him: but the **things which come out of him**, **those are they that defile the man**.

### **Transformed in the Light-by FAITH:**

**Gen 22:8** And Abraham said, My son, **God will provide himself a lamb** for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

**Col 3:10** And have **put on the new [man]**, **which is renewed in knowledge** after **the** image of him that created him: (take on the knowledge of LIFE).

**Rom 13:14** But **put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make not provision for the flesh, to [fulfil] the lusts [thereof].

**A NEW KNOWLEDGE after the TREE of LIFE will be given us in Jesus:**

**Pro 11:30** The **fruit of the righteous** [is] **a tree of life**; and he that winneth souls **[is] wise**.

**Gal 1:4** Who **gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world**, according to the will of God and our Father:

**1Jo 2:8** Again, a **new commandment I write unto** you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the **darkness is past**, and the **true light** now **shineth**. **Note:** Christ is the true Light sent from GOD! Satan had become a distortion of that true light.

### **LET THERE BE LIGHT:**

**Hsa 6:6** For **I desired mercy**, and not sacrifice; and the **knowledge of God** more than burnt offerings. **Note:** I desire Mercy **not animal sacrifice** **Jesus was sent as an act of mercy-a free gift**, an offering (Lamb of God). He was the Lamb that God provided for himself, and SENT to earth.

**1Pe 1:3** Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy **hath begotten us again** unto a lively hope **by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead**,

**Note:** To Beget: To **procreate**, as a father or sire; to generate; commonly said of the father- to father (in this case, by Holy SEED- His Holy Spirit). We are begotten- for yet unto a future time- set in motion, by the Holy Spirit placed within use; that same Glory by which Jesus was raised from the dead, to Eternal Life in Son-ship.

**Psa 2:7** I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou [art] **my Son**; this day have I **begotten thee**.

**Act 13:33** God hath fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that **He hath raised up Jesus again**; as it is also written in the second psalm, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee.

**Hbr 1:5** For unto which of the angels said he at any time, **Thou art my Son**, this day have I begotten thee? And again, **I will be to Him a Father**, and He **shall be to me a Son**? **Note:** Jesus was a BORN SON not a created one (not as the angles); and we shall be born as Jesus was.

**Jud 1:21** Keep yourselves in the love of God, **looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life**. Note: "looking" means to watching- waiting in faith toward that end.

**Rom 9:15** For he saith to Moses, I will have **mercy** on whom I will have **mercy**, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.

**Jhn 1:1** **In the beginning was the Word**, and the **Word was with God**, and the Word was God. **Note:** this denotes the very beginning of all creation, spiritual and physical.

**Jhn 1:2** The **same was** in the beginning **with God**.

**Jhn 1:3** All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

**Jhn 1:4** **In him was life**; and the **life was the light of men**.

**Jhn 1:5** And **the light shineth in darkness**; and **the darkness comprehended it not**.

**Jhn 1:6** There was **a man sent from God**, whose name [was] John.

**Jhn 1:7** The same **came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light**, that all [men] through him might believe.

**Jhn 1:8** He was not that Light, but [was sent] to bear witness of that **Light**.

**Jhn 1:9** [That] was **the true Light**, which lighteth every man that cometh into **the** world. Note: that True Light (Jesus- Word of God) will reveal all secrets (in darkness) in the hearts of men; and will Light the path toward God.

**Jhn 3:16** **For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.** Note: **Salvation is a FREE gift-it cannot be earned.** **Reward is generated from the fruits of the Spirit** worked in FAITH-wisdom in action.

**1Pe 1:10** Of which **salvation** the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied **of the grace [that should come] unto you:** Note: the Grace (gift- Holy Spirit by the sacrifice of His Holy Word, Jesus) of God is wrapped in SALVATION-in the resurrection to Life Eternal in Jesus-but **inheritance is by reward.**

**Jhn 1:17** For the **law was given by Moses**, [but] **grace and truth came by Jesus Christ**. Note: the law of Moses could never Save you-but GRACE (Holy Spirit of God- His Glory of Power) by FAITH in Jesus, will bring you SALVATION.

**Eph 2:8** For **by grace are ye saved through faith;** and that **not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God:**

**Jam 2:22** Seest thou how **faith wrought with his works,** and **by works was faith made perfect?**

**The Glory of God-the GIFT of HIS Holy Spirit –the Holy SEED in Jesus:**

**Luk 11:13** If ye then, being evil, know how to give **good gifts** unto your children: how much more shall **[your] heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him?** Note: The Holy Seed, from the tree of Life, brings the fountain of Living Waters with Him.

**Jesus will grow anew in you, bearing fruit to the Glory of God:**

**Eph 4:13** Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, **unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ**:

**Pro 11:30 The fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life**; and he that winneth souls [is] wise.

**Hbr 2:17** Wherefore in all things it behoved him **to be made like unto his brethren**, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things [pertaining] to God, **to make reconciliation for the sins** of the people.

**Hbr 2:14** Forasmuch then as the children are partakers **of flesh and blood**, **he also himself likewise took part of the same**; **that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death**, that is, **the devil**;

**Hbr 10:5** Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, **Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me**:  
**Note**: Christ had a body of FLESH, to destroy sin while in the flesh; by the power of God's Glory (His Holy Spirit).

**Hbr 10:12** But this man, **after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever**, **sat down on the right hand of God**;

**Eph 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath **given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour**. **Note: Gen 8:21.**

**Hbr 9:26** For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but **now once** in the end of the world hath he **appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself**.

#### **A PROMISE ESTABLISHED ON FAITH:**

**Gen 22:16** And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and **hast not withheld thy son, thine only [son]**:

**Gen 22:17** That **in blessing I will bless** thee, and **in multiplying I will multiply** thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which [is] upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies;

**Gen 22:18** And in thy Seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice. **Note:** One SEED- the Christ.

**Gen 26:4** And I will make **thy seed** to multiply as the stars of heaven, and will give unto **thy seed** all these countries; and in **thy seed shall** all the nations of the earth be blessed;

**Rom 4:13** For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, [was] not to **Abraham**, or to his **seed**, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith. **Note:** Abraham was the father of the faithful; and we shall receive of that same inheritance by Faith in the Word of God.

**Rom 4:16** Therefore [it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the **seed**; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of **Abraham; who is the father of us all**, **Note:** Potentially all mankind, as they choose and believe the Word of God- can become the children of Abraham and heirs with him of Eternal Life.

**Jhn 1:17** For the law was given by Moses, [but] grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

**Gal 3:16** Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy **Seed**, which is **Christ**. **Note:** The promise made to father Abraham can be ours by faith, but it can only come through Jesus (the Word of God) Who established the **promise** by Holy **BLOOD** and the **WATER** of Life (the Holy Spirit).

**Remember:** that the **Water (Holy Spirit)** was turned to Wine (Flesh-Blood).

**The promise** is: **Life Eternal** in an Eternal Kingdom as the Sons of God- brought forth in the GLORY (LIGHT) of God – **HIS HOLY SPIRIT**.

**Psa 105:42** For he remembered his holy **promise**, [and] Abraham his servant.

**Act 13:23** Of this man's seed hath God according to [his] promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus:

**Gal 3:14** That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might **receive the promise of the Spirit through faith**. **Note:** that all of mankind, Jews and Gentiles alike would have access to the promise in Jesus.

**Gal 3:29** And if ye [be] Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and **heirs** according to **the promise**.

**Isa 9:6** For unto us a child is born, **unto us a son is given**: and the **government shall be upon his shoulder**: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty **God**, The everlasting **Father**, The Prince of Peace. **Note:** Jesus (the Word) and the FATHER are both Gods, and are, and shall be Eternal Fathers- both producing children unto Eternal Glory. **Christ is the foundation Stone** upon which the Kingdom rises.

**Mat 22:44** **The LORD said unto my Lord**, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool?

**Mar 12:36** For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, **The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make** thine enemies thy footstool. **Note:** "Holy Ghost" should be understood as Holy Spirit.

**Isa 9:7** Of the increase of **[his] government** and peace [there shall be] no end, **upon the throne of David**, and **upon his kingdom**, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. **The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.**

#### **A SON OF DAVID:**

**Mar 10:48** And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, **[Thou] Son of David**, have mercy on me.

**Act 13:22** And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them **David** to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found **David** the [son] of Jesse, **a man after mine own heart**, which shall fulfil all my will. **Note:** A clean pure (virgin-mind) **heart of HUMILITY**-circumcised.

**Psa 132:11** The LORD hath sworn [in] truth unto David; he will not turn from it; **Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.**

**Rom 1:3** Concerning his **Son** Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;

**A Freewill Offering-a GIFT of God:**

**Jhn 11:50** Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that **one man should die for the people**, and that the whole nation perish not.

**Jhn 18:14** Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people.

**Mat 27:25** Then answered all the people, **and** said, His blood [be] on us, and on our children.

**2Ch 29:24** And the priests killed them, and they **made reconciliation** with their **blood** upon the altar, to make an atonement for all Israel: for the king commanded [that] the burnt offering and the **sin** offering [should be made] **for all Israel**. **Note:** Atonement- Symbolic forgiveness of sin. The blood of animal sacrifice pictured our Lord's Sacrifice to come in the cleansing of sin (an atonement) by HIS Holy BLOOD.

**Eze 43:21** Thou shalt take the bullock also of the **sin** offering, and he shall burn it in the appointed place of the house, without the sanctuary.

**Exd 29:14** But the flesh of the bullock, and his skin, and his dung, shalt thou burn with fire without the camp: it [is] a sin offering.

**Hbr 13:11** For the bodies of those beasts, whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for **sin**, are burned without the camp.

**Hbr 13:12** Wherefore **Jesus also**, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

**Rom 5:15** But not **as** the offence, so also [is] the free gift. For if through the offence of **one** many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, [which is] by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many. **Note:** the offence (to death) of one, is that of Adam- and the gift (Holy Spirit- to Eternal Life) is of Christ.

**Rom 5:12** Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that **all** have sinned:

**Rom 5:16** And not as [it was] by one that sinned, [so is] the gift: for the judgment [was] **by one to condemnation**, but the **free gift** [is] of many offences **unto justification**. **Note:** Jesus became sin (carried our sins) for all mankind unto justification (forgiveness before God)- because HE was (faithful to God) **without sin**. He conquered sin (death) by faith in the perfection (sinless) **of the Holy Spirit** of God; and **was Raised** to Life Eternal by GOD.

**Rom 5:18** Therefore as **by the offence of one [judgment came] upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one [the free gift came] upon all men unto justification of life**. **Note:** Definition, "justification" **to make sinless** - forgiven by Atonement. The Sacrifice of the Holy Lamb of God; was provided for us by God Himself.

**Gen 22:8** And Abraham said, My son, **God will provide himself a lamb** for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.

**Rom 5:19** For as by one man's **disobedience many were made sinners**, so by **the obedience of one shall many be made righteous**.

**2Cr 5:21** For he hath **made him [to be] sin for us**, who knew no sin; that **we might be made the righteousness of God in him**.

**Rom 6:9** Knowing that **Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him**. **Note:** He lives forever in the Spirit of GLORY.

**Hbr 9:28** So **Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many**; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time **without sin unto salvation**. **Note:** At death, His body knew no corruption, for He was resurrected to life eternal with God.

**Act 2:31** He seeing this before **spake of the resurrection of Christ**, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did **see corruption**.

**Psa 16:10** For **thou wilt not leave my soul in hell**; neither wilt thou suffer thine Holy One to **see corruption**. **Note:** Hell is the grave of death- and the soul is the body.

**Rom 6:10** For in that he died, he **died unto sin once**: but **in that he liveth, he liveth unto God**.

**Rev 1:5** And from Jesus Christ, [who is] the faithful witness, [and] the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood, **Note:** He died to destroy death for all, He was the first by Resurrection to cry out Abba (Father- Daddy). He came to destroy the second death (an eternal death, from which there is no return), the first is physical (we are given to physical corruption).

**Rom 5:21** That as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord.

**Rom 6:18** Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

### Redemption and Salvation-two pivotal points:

It first must be noted, that Redemption by definition means to redeem-to buy back. A PRICE must be paid to obtain something that originally belonged to the purchaser. In this case God was the original owner of the sheep; that Satan stole away by guile. Eve was fooled into a death covenant with the Devil-but Adam was disobedient, believing the "word" of Satan over God's- through Eve his wife. They became alienated from God, and sin (darkness) divided them from the LIGHT (Glory) of His Majesty.

**Isa 28:15** Because ye have said, We have made a covenant with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves:

A covenant is an agreement between two or more parties. In this case whether Adam knew it or not, he covenanted with death (Satan-the "god" of death), to live according to the principals of "good and evil". Adam obtained by the fruit (seed of death); a mind that brings on death (the CARNAL MIND)- and he SINNED in disobedience rejecting the LIGHT (Law- Word of God) of the Living God. Now, because this carnal mind is inherited-it would be passed on from generation to generation to all of mankind, leaving us prisoners to death, caught in the death grip of SIN.

**Rom 5:14** Nevertheless, death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come. **Note:** death

reigned even before the written law of God was given in Moses. The Law was put forth to show mankind what sin was; and to make it more sinful.

**Symbolism in the Fruit (Life or its absence Death)- Note:** it must always be remembered that God uses symbolism throughout his Holy Word (the Books). In this regard the Tree of Life was Symbolic of LIFE ETERNAL; and also the "tree of good and evil" was symbolic of eternal DEATH- even though they were real trees, in a real garden.

Because an AGREEMENT (contract) was made-a LIFE was required to fulfill the covenant with death (contract to death)- but the life would be turned into death (darkness) from which there is no return- we are speaking of the second, not the first death. And in so doing, only one life would satisfy the requirement for that one life only, because of sin. But **Christ stepped in**, and in that He LIVED a SINLESS LIFE (He conquered the sting of death SIN)- and being the Lamb of redemption, He paid the PRICE of redemption for all . Our sins are taken away in our Lord Jesus. **Note:** the life that was required, was to fulfill the covenant with death.

**1Cr 15:56** The sting of death [is] sin; and the strength of sin [is] the law.

**1Cr 15:55** O death, where [is] thy sting? O grave, where [is] thy victory?

**Amo 3:3** Can two walk together, except they be agreed? **Note:** Two become as One- they become **united (bond together in agreement)**. A contract binds two individuals together as one.

**1Jo 3:5** And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

**1Jo 3:8** He that committeth **sin is of the devil**; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

**1Jo 3:4** Whosoever committeth **sin transgresseth also the law**: for **sin is the transgression of the law**. **Note:** the Law is completed in LOVE.

**Rev 20:6** Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they

shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

**Hbr 9:27** And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: **Note:** This is the natural death of the material flesh- the first death. This is not an eternal death-as the second is.

**1Cr 15:56** The sting of death [is] sin; and the strength of sin [is] the law. **Note:** the Law establishes what sin is. Sin brings on death- the Law (Light), uncovers the darkness (the law reveals sin). Christ took VICTORY OVER DEATH and the MIND of Satan, by LIGHT (Glory of God).

**1Cr 15:55** O death, where [is] thy **sting**? O grave, where [is] thy victory?

**God's Covenant was of Light in Righteousness-written in Holy Blood:**

**Psa 111:9** He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant forever: holy and reverend [is] his name. **Note:** Jesus (the Light of God-His Holy Word), was sent to earth as our redeemer.

**Hbr 9:15** And for this cause **he is the mediator of the new testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

**Eph 1:7** In whom **we have redemption through his blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of **his grace**;

**Rom 5:10** For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life. **Note:** We are reconciled (brought back to God- in the **forgiveness of sin- being justified by His Blood**), in His DEATH, but we are **SAVED in HIS LIFE**.

**IMPORTANT POINTS: formed in Mercy, founded on Grace:**

Redemption (Returned to God), and Salvation (In His Resurrection-to Life Again), are framed within the following points:

**1Cr 1:30** But of him are ye in **Christ Jesus**, who of God is made unto us **wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption**:

**Eph 1:14** Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. **Note:** We have not yet received full redemption-because, full redemption involves an inheritance of Eternal LIFE, within a promised **Eternal Kingdom**.

**Mat 6:33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

**Rom 8:23** And not only [they], but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, **waiting for the adoption, [to wit], the redemption of our body.**

### 1. Justification-founded on Faith

**Rom 5:18** Therefore as by the offence of one [judgment came] upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one [the free gift came] upon all men unto justification of life.  
**Definition (justification):** The act of justifying, or the state of being justified, in respect to God's requirements. **To be found guiltless-FORGIVEN** (made CLEAN before God- for we Broke His Law).

**Psa 32:2** Blessed [is] the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit [there is] **no guile**. **Note:** No guile-No sin.

**Job 25:4** How then can man be **justified** with God? or how can he be clean [that is] born of a woman? **Note:** through Christ only.

**Act 13:39** And by him all that believe are justified from all things, from which **ye could not be justified by the law of Moses**. **Note:** The law of Moses could **NOT** justify us- only the Blood of Christ.

**Rom 3:24** Being **justified** freely by his grace through the redemption that is in **Christ Jesus**:

**Rom 5:1** Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

### 2. Reconciliation-founded on Faith

**2Cr 5:18** And all things [are] of God, who hath **reconciled** us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;  
**Definition of Reconciliation:** the reestablishing of cordial relations. REESTABLISHING a relationship with God.

**2Cr 5:19** To wit, that **God was in Christ, reconciling the world** unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. **Note: God and Christ are ONE!**

**Col 1:20** And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him **to reconcile all things unto himself**; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven.

**Col 1:21** And you, that were sometime alienated and **enemies in [your] mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled.**

**Hbr 2:17** Wherefore **in all things** it behoved him **to be made like unto [his] brethren**, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things [pertaining] to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. **Note:** Christ was made JUST LIKE US- except that he was filled with the Spirit of God, and we can be also, through HIM.

**Rom 5:10** For if, when we were enemies, **we were reconciled to God by the death** of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

**Eph 2:16** And that he might reconcile **both** unto God in one body by the cross, **having slain the enmity** thereby: **Note:** we are no longer two, but ONE with God and Christ.

### **3. Inheritance (a PROMISE)- founded on Faith**

**Rom 4:13** For the promise, **that he should be the heir of the world**, [was] not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the **righteousness of faith.**

**Definition of heir:** hereditary succession to a title or an office or property that which is inherited- a title or property or estate that passes by law to the heir on the death of the owner

**Jam 2:23** And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, **Abraham believed God**, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God.

**Col 3:24** Knowing that **of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance:** for ye serve the Lord Christ.

**Act 26:18** To open their eyes, [and] **to turn [them] from darkness to light**, and [from] the power of Satan **unto God**, that they may

receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

**Col 1:12** Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be **partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light**:

Note: (Light) Inherit the Glory of God-unto eternal life.

**Mat 22:32** I am the God of Abraham, and the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob? **God is not the God of the dead, but of the living**.

**Rom 8:17** And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with [him], that we may be also glorified together. **Note**: to become LIGHT as God is-to become LOVE as He is.

**Gal 3:29** And if ye [be] Christ's, then are ye **Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise**.

**Hbr 6:17** Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, **confirmed [it] by an oath**:

**Hbr 6:18** That by two immutable things, in which **[it was] impossible for God to lie**, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

**4. Covenant LAW** (Contract-Testament-Will) – Old and New-established on FAITH:

**Gen 9:9** And I, behold, **I establish my covenant with you**, and with your **seed after you**; **Note**: God was speaking to Noah, establishing that He would no longer destroy all flesh from off the earth, for perpetual generations. That covenant would be continually reestablished through out their generations- but would change from flesh to spirit in an everlasting covenant in Jesus.

**Definition of covenant**: a **signed written agreement** between two or more parties (nations) to perform some action. (Biblical meaning) an agreement between God and his people, in which God makes certain promises and requires certain behavior from them in return. **Note**: The **requirement from God was (is)-Obedience and Faith**.

**Gen 15:18** In the same day **the LORD made a covenant with Abram**, saying, **Unto thy seed have I given this land**, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:

**Gen 17:2** And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.

**Gen 17:4** As for me, behold, my covenant [is] with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations.

**Gen 17:7** And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be a God unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

**Gen 17:9** And God said unto Abraham, **Thou shalt keep my covenant** therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.

**Gen 17:10** This [is] my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised. Note: This circumcision was a forerunner of the circumcision of the heart (a spiritual circumcision).

**Gen 17:11** And ye shall circumcise the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of the covenant betwixt me and you.

**Deu 4:13** And he declared unto you his covenant, which he commanded you to perform, [even] ten commandments; and he wrote them upon two tables of stone. **Note:** First commandments written on hardened stone to match Israel's hardened HEARTS (stiff necks)- but they were latter to be placed on the soft tablets of the heart.

**Hbr 9:22** And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

**Rom 5:20** Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: **Note:** A covenant law entered in, to show us what sin is. Grace (gifts) came in Jesus Christ for the remission of sins for all.

**Rom 15:8** Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises [made] unto the fathers:

**Act 7:8** And he gave him the covenant of circumcision: and so [Abraham] begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac [begat] Jacob; and Jacob [begat] the twelve patriarchs.

**Hbr 8:8** For **finding fault with them**, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when **I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah:** **Note:** The seed of Abraham.

**Hbr 8:9** **Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers** in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; **because they continued not in my covenant**, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. **Note:** **A New Covenant** (Testament) came forth in Jesus-having the grace of His Glory (His Holy Spirit-in Christ) shine upon us. The Old was of a physical law, written on physical stone; but the New was ushered in by GRACE, and that by Faith.

Hbr 9:15 And for **this cause he is the mediator of the new testament**, that **by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament**, they which are called **might receive the promise of eternal inheritance**.

**Gal 3:17** And this I say, [that] **the covenant**, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, **the law**, which was four hundred and thirty years after, **cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect**. **Note:** the **New Covenant** was established on FAITH-it being of **PROMISE**. The New Covenant is of the **LAW in FULL SPIRITUAL INTENT-LOVE!** This is the law's original form-the Royal Law, of, The Kingdom of GOD. It is therefore, impossible for the Old Covenant Law to destroy the Promise, first made to Abraham.

**Rom 4:12** And the father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, **but who also walk in the steps of that faith of our father Abraham, which [he had] being [yet] uncircumcised**. **Note:** Abraham had already covenanted with God before he was circumcised in the flesh-because he was already circumcised in the Spirit of his heart by FAITH in God. HE BELIEVED GOD!

**Deu 10:16** **Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart**, and be no more stiffnecked.

**Deu 30:6** And the LORD thy **God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed**, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live.

**Jer 4:4** **Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your heart**, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings. **Note:** take away the hood of covering.

**Hbr 8:10** For this [is] the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts;** and **I will be to them a God,** and **they shall be to me a people;** **Note:** Heart and mind are alike. **Heart here is the seat of emotions, established in the mind.**

**Hbr 10:16** This [is] the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, **I will put my laws into their hearts,** and in their **minds will I write them;** **Note:** A New Covenant of Faith-by the Blood of Christ. Does this sound like the Commandments are done away?

**Rev 14:12** Here is the patience of the saints: **here [are] they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.** **Note:** The Saints of God are Commandment keepers-having them written on the soft tablets of their hearts. They are kept in Faith through Jesus living in them, bearing fruit to the Glory of God.

**2Cr 6:16** And what agreement hath the temple of God with idols? for **ye are the temple of the living God;** as God hath said, **I will dwell in them,** and **walk in [them];** and **I will be their God,** and **they shall be my people.**

**Hbr 12:2** Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of [our] faith; who **for the joy that was set before him endured the cross,** despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God.

**Jam 2:17** Even so faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. **Note:** **Faith must be worked to bear fruit-And it can only be worked through Jesus by Wisdom.**

**Jam 2:18** Yea, a man may say, Thou hast faith, and I have works: shew me thy faith without thy works, and **I will shew thee my faith by my works.**

**Jam 5:15** And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. **Note:** **PRAYER is a work**-an act of Godly Wisdom-as is **Bible study, Meditation, and all acts of Godly CHARITY (LOVE towards God and others).** These are all acts of faith, these are all Faith in action- THIS IS **GODLY WISDOM!**

**Gal 3:7** Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

**Gal 3:9** So then **they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham**.

**Gal 3:14** That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; **that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith**. **Note:** So now blessings can come to all.

**Rom 4:13** For **the promise**, that he should be the heir of the world, [was] not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but **through the righteousness of faith**.

**Rom 4:16** Therefore **[it is] of faith, that [it might be] by grace**; to the **end the promise might be sure to all the seed**; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all, **Note:** not just to the Jew-but to all mankind.

**Rom 4:3** For what saith the scripture? **Abraham believed God**, and it was counted unto him for righteousness.

**NOTE:** Prayer is an act (action) of faith- wisdom in action, and this wisdom comes from the tree of life by the Light of God (His Holy Spirit).

**Pro 3:18** **She [is] a tree of life** to them that lay hold upon her: and happy [is every one] that retaineth her. **Note: Speaking of Wisdom (she)**.

**Pro 11:30** The **fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life**; and he that winneth souls **[is] wise**.

**5. HIS BLOOD**-life is in the blood, and the shedding of blood brought forth the remission of SINS- and established the Covenant dedicated by Blood:

**Hbr 9:18** Whereupon **neither** the first [testament] **was dedicated without blood**.

**Col 1:14** In whom **we have redemption through his blood**, [even] the forgiveness of sins:

**Gen 9:4** But **flesh with the life thereof, [which is] the blood** thereof, shall ye not eat.

**Hbr 13:20** Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, **through the blood of the everlasting covenant**, Note: The Covenant was dedicated by Blood-the **Blood was the LIFE** of JESUS.

**Have you ever wondered why Cain's offering was not accepted of God?**

**Gen 4:1** And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare **Cain**, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD.

**Gen 4:2** And she again bare his brother Abel. And **Abel was a keeper of sheep**, but **Cain** was a tiller of the ground.

**Gen 4:3** And in process of time it came to pass, that **Cain** brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the LORD.

**Gen 4:5** But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And **Cain** was very wrath, and his countenance fell. **Note: the answer lies in the fact, that Cain brought a BLOODLESS sacrifice before God. It had already been established, that in order that mankind be redeemed (reconciled) back to God, from the hand of the Devil- a Human Life would have to be required for every Human Life. Life for Life-Blood is the transfer fluid in the material flesh kind. Blood carries the breath of Life (oxygen) from God. Vegetation has no Blood-but sheep, having Blood Life within, were the perfect symbolic offering of quite, HUMBLE, purity (if they be without blemish), before God-a sacrifice of Life, a sacrifice of purity, a SACRIFICE of FAITH (a REDEEMER would come).**

**In order to qualify** (to conquer the Devils covenant) as the Holy Lamb of God, Christ had to be **PURE** (without blemish-**sinless**). His ONE Life would have to equal ALL lives. And also being the Second Adam- he also would be **made like Adam- FLESH and BLOOD** (having LIFE in the material realm). There is one more event, which HAD TO TAKE PLACE- Jesus **would have to come back from DEATH**, not back into the material, but back into the SPIRITUAL- HE LIVES ANEW, FOREVER. My beloved, this is LIFE, this is SALVATION from eternal death. **This Eternal Salvation was established on the FAITH of PROMISE.**

**Exd 12:7** And they shall **take of the blood**, and strike [it] on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall **eat it**.

**Exd 12:13** And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye [are]: and when **I see the blood, I will pass over you**, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy [you], when I smite the land of Egypt. **Note:** the plague was that of death- a type of eternal death in sin, which Jesus destroyed for us (**death will Passover us-** by the Blood of the Holy Lamb of God).

**Exd 24:8** And **Moses took the blood, and sprinkled [it] on the people**, and said, **Behold the blood of the covenant**, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.

**Hbr 9:7** But into the second [went] the high priest alone once every year, **not without blood**, which he offered for himself, and [for] the errors of the people:

**Hbr 9:22** And almost **all things are by the law purged with blood;** and **without shedding of blood is no remission.**

**1Pe 1:19** But with **the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot**: **Note:** Without Sin-like unleavened BREAD- HUMBLE, without guile.

**Mat 26:28** For **this is my blood of the new testament**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. **Note:** The New Testament came into affect **at the death of the testator** (Jesus the Christ).

**Mar 14:24** And he said unto them, **This is my blood of the new testament**, which is shed for many.

**1Cr 11:25** After the same manner also [he took] the cup, when he had supped, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood**: this do ye, as oft as ye drink [it], **in remembrance of me**.

**1Jo 1:7** But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the **blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin**.

**1Jo 5:6** **This is he that came by water and blood, [even] Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood**. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth. **Note:** Water represents the Holy Spirit-the Blood material FLESH. The WATER was turned INTO BLOOD- the Spirit became FLESH-remember the water to wine principal.

**Rev 1:5** And from Jesus Christ, [who is] the faithful witness, [and] the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in his own blood,

**Eph 1:7** In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

## **6. His Body (Unleavened Bread) broken for us:**

**Jhn 1:14** And **the Word was made flesh,** and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

**1Jo 3:5** And ye know that he was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.

**1Jo 4:10** Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son [to be] the propitiation for our sins. Note: God loved us while we were still in our sin.

**Jhn 6:53** Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye **eat the flesh of the Son of man,** and **drink his blood,** ye have no life in you. Note: His flesh and Blood—became Eternal Spirit AGAIN.

**Jhn 6:52** The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can **this man give us [his] flesh to eat?**

**Isa 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because **the LORD hath anointed me** to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them **that** are] bound;

**Mat 26:12** For in that she hath poured this ointment on my body, she did [it] for my burial. Note: **Mary poured the sweet ointments on Jesus,** as **He was the anointed of God, A SWEET SMELLING SAVOR** to God- a Sacrifice of perfection, without blemish (without sin). This act will be remembered forever, and told throughout the world. Jesus was the SACRIFICE of COVENANT VOWS-He was and is, BEAUTIFUL before GOD.

**Jhn 11:2** (It was [that] Mary which **anointed** the Lord with ointment, and wiped his feet with her hair, whose brother Lazarus was sick.)

**Lev 3:5** And Aaron's sons shall burn it on the altar upon the burnt sacrifice, which [is] upon the wood that [is] on the fire: [it is] an offering made by fire, of **a sweet savour unto the LORD.**

**Mat 26:26** And as they were eating, **Jesus took bread, and blessed [it],** and brake [it], and gave [it] to the disciples, and said, **Take, eat; this is my body.**

**Rom 7:4** Wherefore, my brethren, ye also are become **dead to the law** by **the body of Christ; that ye should be married to another,** [even] **to him who is raised from the dead,** that we should bring forth fruit unto God.

**Note:** A New Covenant- in the New Body of Christ (a Spiritual Body). We are now married to our NEW Husband (Jesus who LIVES), in an Eternal Covenant. We are dead to the law of physical ordinance-which in the keeping could never save us- but have **become ONE with God** in an Eternal Covenant (magnified Law of Love) of LIFE, in His Word of Promise, Jesus Christ.

**Mat 19:5** And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they **twain shall be one flesh?**

**Eph 5:30** For **we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.**

**Eph 2:14** For he is our peace, **who hath made both one,** and hath broken down the middle wall of partition [between us]; **Note:** the Vale- that is His Body was torn, so that we now have access to God- and we can KNOW Him as He IS.

**Eph 2:15** Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, [even] the law of commandments [contained] in ordinances; for **to make in himself of twain one new man,** [so] making peace; **Note:** No longer TWO, but ONE.

**Rom 8:3** For what **the law could not do,** in that it was weak through the flesh, **God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh,** and for sin, **condemned sin in the flesh:**

**Rom 8:10** And if Christ [be] in you, the **body [is] dead because of sin;** but **the Spirit [is] life because of righteousness.** **Note:** We bury the old man daily with Christ-as we are refreshed to LIFE anew in HIS Resurrection from the dead.

**1Cr 11:24** And when he had given thanks, he brake [it], and said, Take, eat: **this is my body, which is broken for you**: this do in remembrance of me.

**Job 33:21** His flesh is consumed away, that it cannot be seen; and his bones [that] were not seen stick out.

**Gal 1:4** Who **gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world**, according to the will of God and our Father:

**1Pe 2:24** **Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree**, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

**Hbr 10:20** By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, **through the veil, that is to say, his flesh**;

## 7. The Spirit of ADOPTION:

**Rom 8:15** For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but **ye have received the Spirit of adoption**, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

**Rom 8:23** And not only [they], but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for **the adoption, [to wit], the redemption of our body**. **Note**: body (flesh) changed to a Spirit Body (Eternal), by redemption.

**Rom 9:4** Who are **Israelites; to whom [pertaineth] the adoption**, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service [of God], and the promises; **Note**: He is a Jew who is one inwardly, by circumcision of the HEART.

**Gal 4:5** To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive **the adoption of sons**. **Note**: We are no more under the law of the flesh-but we keep the LAW (of LOVE) by Grace (Holy Spirit) in Christ Jesus.

**Eph 1:5** Having predestinated **us unto the adoption of children** by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

### **Salvation in His Resurrection to Eternal Life:**

**We are Saved by His Life**-from eternal death by the Resurrection of God.

**Rom 6:23** For the wages of sin [is] death; but **the gift of God [is] eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.**

**Rom 5:10** For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, **being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.**

**Rom 1:4** And declared [to be] the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, **by the resurrection from the dead:**

**Rom 6:5** For if we have been **planted together in** the likeness of his **death, we shall be also [in the likeness] of [his] resurrection:**

**Note:** **Planted** with Him **by water Baptism-** the burial of the old man of sin. Then we shall be raised in His likeness of Eternal Spirit.

**1Cr 15:42** So also [is] the resurrection of the dead. **It is sown in corruption;** it is **raised in incorruption:** **Note:** From flesh to Spirit (from mortal to immortal).

**Hbr 9:12** Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, **having obtained eternal redemption [for us].**

**2Sa 22:3** The God of my rock; in him will I trust: [he is] my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, **my saviour;** **thou savest me from violence.**

**Psa 3:8** **Salvation [belongeth] unto the LORD:** thy blessing [is] upon thy people. Selah.

**Psa 14:7** Oh that **the salvation of Israel [were come] out of Zion!** when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, [and] Israel shall be glad.

**Act 28:28** Be it known therefore unto you, that the **salvation of God is sent unto the Gentiles,** and [that] they will hear it.

**Rom 1:16** For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the **power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. **Note:** Salvation comes to all mankind.

**1Th 5:9** For **God hath not appointed us to wrath**, but **to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ**,

**Hbr 1:14** Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? **Note:** this is speaking of angels, as being ministering spirits to the children of God.

**Hbr 2:10** For it became him, for whom [are] all things, and by whom [are] all things, **in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings**.

**Luk 1:77** **To give knowledge of salvation** unto his people by the remission of their sins,

**Hbr 9:28** So Christ **was once offered to bear the sins of many**; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

**Hbr 5:9** And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

**1Pe 1:4** **To an inheritance incorruptible**, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

**Rom 5:9** Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

**Rom 10:9** That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt **believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved**.

**Tts 3:5** **Not by works of righteousness which we have done**, but **according to his mercy he saved us**, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; **Note:** Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit).

**Mar 16:16** He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

**Rom 6:5** For if **we have been planted together in the likeness of his death**, we **shall be also [in the likeness] of [his] resurrection**:  
**Note:** BAPTISM (planted) is a type of burial, of the old man of sin.

**Isa 45:17** [But] Israel shall be saved in the LORD **with an everlasting salvation**: ye shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end.

**Jer 4:14** O Jerusalem, **wash thine heart** from wickedness, that thou mayest be saved. How long shall thy vain thoughts lodge within thee?

Sin begets sin in the Carnal mind of Satan the devil, and must be cut out of our lives by the Holy Word of God; by way of the CIRCUMCISION of our HEARTS. The carnal mind of Satan is a mind of HARDNESS, which must be circumcised from off our hearts (minds), as we take on the New Mind of JESUS CHRIST.

**Psa 106:10** And **he saved them from the hand of him that hated [them]**, and **redeemed them from the hand of the enemy**. **Note:** saved from Satan- and saved from eternal death.

**Gen 6:5** And GOD saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every imagination of **the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually**.

**Hbr 3:10** Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They **do alway err in [their] heart; and they have not known my ways**.

**Hbr 3:12** **Take heed, brethren**, lest there be in any of you **an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God**.

**Mar 8:17** And when Jesus knew [it], he saith unto them, Why reason ye, because ye have no bread? perceive ye not yet, neither understand? **have ye your heart yet hardened?**

**Mar 10:5** And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the **hardness of your heart** he wrote you this precept.

**Note:** Satan's HEART was Blinded (hardened) by PRIDE and VAINITY- He was LIFTED UP because of His BEAUTY. A type of foreskin grew over his heart, which also grew over his children's hearts.

**2Cr 4:4** In whom **the god of this world hath blinded the minds** of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.

**Eph 4:18** Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart:

**Jhn 12:40** He hath blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with [their] eyes, nor understand with [their] heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. **Note:** God allowed their blindness for a future purpose.

**Rom 11:7** What then? Israel hath not obtained that which he seeketh for; but the election hath obtained it, and the rest were blinded

**1Jo 2:11** But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. **Note:** Who is the "god" of darkness and death?

**2Cr 3:15** But even unto this day, when Moses is read, the vail is upon their heart.

**2Cr 3:14** But their minds were blinded: for until this day remaineth the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old testament; which [vail] is done away in Christ.

Jesus carried ALL our sins to the GRAVE, as He was the PRICE of REDEMPTION for us. Even though He was without sin Himself, **He became sin for us in His BODY of FLESH.** Symbolically speaking, He became the covering over our hearts, which needed circumcision. Can you grasp what our Beloved did for us, that at the final hour His Father could not look upon Him; for He became sin for us, taking it to the GRAVE forever.

**Mat 27:46** And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?

**Hbr 10:20** By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

**Gal 1:4** Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world, according to the will of God and our Father:

**1Pe 2:24** Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by

whose stripes ye were healed. **Note:** What TREE? Could it be that this **Cross-** or pole was symbolic of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil? Could it also be, that by the tearing of His FLESH our minds (hearts) would now be able to SEE and be healed of our blindness; this is much more than just the healing of physical sickness?

**Mat 27:51** And, **behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom**; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent; **Note:** That by the tearing of the Veil, we could now SEE God, as JOB finally did. Job received circumcision by the Word of God-It cut his heart- he was circumcised.

**Job 42:5** I have heard of **thee** by the hearing of the ear: but **now mine eye seeth thee**.

**Job 42:6** Wherefore **I abhor [myself]**, and repent in dust and ashes.

**Mar 15:38** And **the veil of the temple was rent in twain** from the top to the bottom.

**Luk 23:45** And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was rent in the midst. **Note:** This represented the body (flesh) of Christ, torn for us, so we could SEE! **The veil (hood of covering) is removed from off our eyes.**

**Hbr 6:19** Which [hope] we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and **which entereth into that within the veil**; **Note:** We now have access to God, in the Holy of Holies –Jesus being the mediator (High Priest).

**Psa 146:8** The LORD openeth [the eyes of] the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down: the LORD loveth the righteous: **Note:** The bowed down, are the HUMBLE (circumcised of God).

**Job 29:15** I was eyes to the blind, and feet [was] I to the lame.

**Isa 42:18** Hear, ye deaf; and **look, ye blind, that ye may see**.

**Isa 42:7** To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

**Isa 42:16** And I will bring the blind by a way [that] they knew not; I will lead them in paths [that] they have not known: **I will make darkness light** before them, **and crooked things straight**. These

things will I do unto them, **and not forsake them**. **Note:** The straight and narrow path toward God. The straight path- is **for the HUMBLE (LOWLY in heart) people of God; these are the Circumcised of God.**

**Zec 9:9** Rejoice greatly, O daughter **of** Zion; shout, O daughter **of** Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he [is] just, and having salvation; **lowly**, and riding upon an **ass**, and upon a **colt** the foal **of** an **ass**. **Note:** Christ humbled Himself in the flesh setting us an example.

**Mat 21:5** Tell ye the daughter **of** Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, **meek**, and sitting upon an **ass**, and a **colt** the foal **of** an **ass**.

**Phi 2:8** And **being found in fashion as a man**, he **humbled himself**, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

**Mat 5:5** **Blessed [are] the meek:** for they shall inherit **the** earth.

**Hbr 12:13** And **make straight paths for your feet**, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.

**Mat 7:13** **Enter ye in at the strait gate:** for **wide [is] the gate**, and **broad [is] the way**, that leadeth to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat: **Note: being straight, is to be not lifted up by way of PRIDE.**

**Mat 7:14** **Because strait [is] the gate**, and **narrow [is] the way**, which leadeth unto life, and **few** there be **that find it**.

**Isa 29:18** And **in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book**, and the **eyes of the blind shall see** out of obscurity, and out of darkness.

**Isa 35:5** Then **the eyes of the blind shall be opened**, and the **ears** of the deaf **shall be unstopped**. **Note:** are you blinded, and deaf?

**Deu 30:6** And the LORD **thy God will circumcise thine heart**, **and the heart of thy seed**, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, **that thou mayest live**.

**2Cr 3:3** [Forasmuch as ye are] manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, **but in fleshy tables of the heart**. **Note:** Speaking of the Commandments, written anew on the tablets of your hearts.

**Rom 6:6** Knowing this, **that our old man is crucified with [him]**, that **the body of sin might be destroyed**, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

**Deu 10:16 Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your heart**, and be no more stiffnecked.

**Hbr 9:14** How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, **purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?**

**1Pe 4:1** Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise **with the same mind**: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;

**2Ti 1:7** For God hath not given us the **spirit** of fear; but **of power**, and **of love**, and **of a sound mind**.

**Rom 12:2** And **be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind**, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**Phl 2:5** Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

Eph 4:23 And **be renewed in the spirit of your mind**;

The **Circumcision of God comes by way of HUMILITY**:

**Note**: Humility is to **LOWER ONESELF DOWN in MIND**. Remember Satan's mind was filled with **Pride and Vanity-lifting himself up in his own mind**.

**Rom 4:11** And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the **faith which [he had yet]** being uncircumcised: **that he might be the father of all them that believe**, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also: **Note**: Speaking of Abraham-he was uncircumcised yet in the flesh-but his heart was Faithful, and clean before God by FAITH in the Word of God.

**Rom 2:29** But **he [is] a Jew, which is one inwardly**; and **circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the spirit, [and] not in the letter**; whose praise [is] not of men, but of God. **Note**: The laws of the flesh (letter) have perished in Christ-but the commandments we keep are written on the soft places of our circumcised hearts (we keep them in the

Spirit of Christ Jesus-with God all things are possible); these being the LAWS of LOVE.

**Phi 2:3** [Let] nothing [be done] through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.

**Rom 12:16** [Be] of the same mind one toward another. **Mind not high things**, but **condescend to men of low estate**. Be not wise in your own conceits.

**Isa 57:15** For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name [is] Holy; **I dwell in the high and holy [place], with him also [that is] of a contrite and humble spirit**, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.

**Psa 37:11** But **the meek shall inherit the earth**; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.

**Psa 76:9** When God arose to judgment, **to save all the meek** of the earth. Selah.

**Psa 147:6** **The LORD lifteth up the meek**: he casteth the wicked down to the ground. **Note**: Satan and his demons were cast back to this earth.

**Psa 149:4** For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: **he will beautify the meek with salvation**.

**Isa 61:1** The Spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound;

**Mat 5:5** Blessed [are] the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.

**Mat 11:29** Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; **for I am meek and lowly in heart**: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

**Mat 21:5** Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass.

**1Pe 3:4** But [let it be] the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, [even the ornament] of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price.

**Phi 2:2** Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, **[being] of one accord, of one mind**

**1Pe 3:8** Finally, **[be ye] all of one mind**, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, [be] pitiful, [be] courteous:

**Act 2:46** And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and **singleness of heart**,

**Jhn 17:11** And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, **that they may be one, as we [are]**.

**Jhn 17:21** **That they all may be one**; as **thou, Father, [art] in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us**: that the world may believe that **thou hast sent me**.

**Jhn 17:22** And the **glory** which thou gavest me I have given them; **that they may be one, even as we are one**: Note: Holy Spirit.

**Isa 54:5** **For thy Maker [is] thine husband**; the LORD of hosts [is] his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; **The God of the whole earth shall he be called**.

**Zec 14:9** And the LORD shall be king over all the earth: **in that day shall there be one LORD, and his name one**. Note: We will all be One in each other-and our God will be part of us as we will be part of Him. We will dwell in Him forever, **being of ONE MIND!**

**Deu 6:4** Hear, O Israel: **The LORD our God [is] one LORD**: Note: Single Minded; of the SAME Spirit (Glory)-we AGREE as ONE.

**Mar 12:29** And Jesus answered him, **The first of all the commandments** [is], Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: Note: **SINGLENESSE of HEART, with GOD and our CHRIST (UNITED as ONE- MARRIED)**.

**Rev 1:5** And from Jesus Christ, [who is] the faithful witness, [and] the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto him that loved us, and **washed us from our sins in his own blood**,

**Eph 5:26** That he might sanctify and **cleanse it with the washing of water by the word**,

**Note:** By the Word of God came the fountains of Living Water (Holy Spirit of God). **Salvation, is Life evermore in the Kingdom of the Living God. We are washed by His Word in Living WATERS (His Holy Spirit).**

**Eph 1:17** That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may **give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him**:

To be made PERFECT in ONE:

**Jhn 17:23** **I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one**; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. **Note:** **CHRIST** was the LIGHT of GOD **SENT** into a world of darkness, **bringing us SALVATION** from DEATH.

**Gen 1:3** And **God said, Let there be light: and there was light.**

**Jhn 1:1** **In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.**

**1Jo 1:1** That **which was from the beginning**, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life; **Note:** The WORD of God was SENT to earth becoming the Living CHRIST- **the witnesses give testimony.**

**Jhn 1:4** **In him was life; and the life was the light of men.**

**Jhn 1:5** And the **light shineth in darkness**; and the darkness comprehended it not.

**1Jo 2:8** Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because **the darkness is past**, and the **true light now shineth.**

**Rev 22:5** And **there shall be no night there**; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for **the Lord God giveth them light**: and they shall reign for ever and ever. **Note:** **no darkness of evil death there-just Life.**

**Rev 21:4** And God **shall** wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there **shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying**, neither **shall** there **be** any **more pain**: for **the former things are passed away**.

**Hbr 2:10** For it became him, for whom [are] all things, and by whom [are] all things, **in bringing many sons unto glory**, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings.

**Hbr 5:9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation** unto all them that obey him;

**Mat 5:48** Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven **is perfect**.

**2Cr 13:11 Finally, brethren, farewell**. Be perfect, be of good comfort, **be of one mind**, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

**Eph 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:**

And who's children do you want to be?

**Mat 13:38** The field is the world; the **good seed are the children of the kingdom**; **but the tares are the children of the wicked [one]**;

**Let me end, by asking the question again: Did God Create moral evil?**
